If you are a grad assistant, scholar, fellow, employee-in-training, or short-term academic staff member who is eligible to enroll in new employee benefits this fall:

- You have 30 days from your benefits-eligible hire date to enroll in or decline insurance.
- If we receive your health enrollment by the deadline, once processed your health insurance will begin as of the first day of the month on or following your eligible hire date.
