- April 12-16 is Tornado and Severe (dangerous) Weather Awareness (watchfulness, understanding) week in Wisconsin.
- **Tornado Watch** = it's possible a tornado could happen.
 - Continue normal activities, but be careful and watch for weather updates (new information).
- **Tornado Warning** = there is a tornado nearby.
 - You will hear an emergency siren (loud sound) if there is danger in your area.
 - If there is a tornado, go to a lower floor or basement away from windows or doors.
- **Tornado Drill** = practice for a tornado warning.
