New words of the week:

- If you are fully vaccinated (completed all COVID-19 shots at least 2 weeks ago), you are exempt from (don't have to do) on-campus COVID testing.
- Your Badger Badge will remain (stay) green unless (except if) you report you are sick or test positive.
- 2nd and 3rd shift employees who are not already vaccinated can get your first COVID-19 vaccine dose (shot) at Carson Gulley Center on:
 - April 1, 6-8 pm (2nd shift)
 - April 2, 6-8 am (3rd shift)
- There will be more 2nd and 3rd shift vaccine clinics (places and times for shots) in the future.
- For the fall semester, UW will have a new normal (new way of doing regular activities).
