As we **transition** (change, move) from spring into summer, UW-Madison is **modifying** (changing) some COVID-19 **protocols** (rules):

- Campus is open to visitors.
- You don't need a green Badger Badge to **access** (go into) most buildings.
- Some campus spaces and events may still require a green Badger Badge.
- If you are not fully vaccinated and need a green Badger Badge, you should test every 8 days.
- Campus COVID tests will use nasal (nose) swabs this summer – no saliva tests.
- You can get a vaccine with no appointment at the Nicholas Recreation Center.
- You don't need to wear masks in outdoor settings (places) but you still need to wear them indoors and in buses or when two or more people are in a university vehicle (car, van, truck).
