

In 1665, England had an epidemic of bubonic plague (a deadly infectious disease). Cambridge University was closed, so Isaac Newton and the students were sent home. Newton spent the next two years on his aunt's farm. During this time, he developed the main ideas of calculus and the laws of physics.
