- Short-term cost-saving measure: a way for a company (to save money over a short period of time (a few months).
- Intermittent furlough: time off without pay in separate periods.
- Position-specific furlough:
 continuous time off without pay
 when there is not enough work
 or if an employee cannot work
 remotely. The department
 determines how long the
 furlough will last and if it is for all
 or a part of an employee's
 normal work schedule.
- Work-Share Program: employees work reduced hours and apply for unemployment benefits to supplement the lost wages.
- Reassignment: employees perform work that is not part of their regular functions or may be located away from their current work unit.
