## Noun or verb?

Some **2-syllable English words** can be a noun or a verb. If you say the **first** syllable louder, it's a **noun**. If you say the **second** syllable louder, it's a **verb**. Examples:

Nouns	Verbs
Permit (PER-mit)= a document that allows you to	Permit (per-MIT) = allow, give permission to do
do something	something
<ul> <li>I need to get a parking <u>permit</u> for Lot 29.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Some streets per<u>mit</u> free two-hour parking.</li> </ul>
Refund (RE-fund) = money	Refund (re-FUND) = to give money back.
I got a <u>re</u> fund for the items I returned.	Please refund my money.
1 got a <u>ro</u> rana for the items i retained.	in industrial in in inches.
Invite (IN-vite) = an invitation	Invite (in-VITE) = to ask someone to come
Did you get an <b>invite</b> to the party?	I will <b>invite</b> you to the meeting.
Dia you got an <u>m</u> ino to the party.	you to the meaning.
Project (PRO-ject) = specific kind of work	Project (pro-JECT) = to give a prediction
We have to finish this <b>project</b> today.	They project COVID-19 cases will rise.
Protest (PRO-test) = an organized demonstration	Protest (pro-TEST) = to march or demonstrate
against something	against something
There is a <b>protest</b> about the state face	They march to <b>protest</b> police violence.
